1. Call Meeting to Order by Mayor Rob Wilkening and say the Pledge of Allegiance.

d. Ron updated on the Gross Alpha levels in the water. Ron has adjusted the backflushing to twice a week and has sent in water samples. The city will be required to provide updates to the community until the levels have returned to normal for one year.

a. As of 01/31/26 there were (10) No Pay (45,112,90,127,20,69,71,88,02,17) and (10) Partial payments (43,64,16,31,121,96,99,104,108,114). A total of \$2,289.29 was not collected, 88,02, and 17 received shut-off notices, and 06 remains turned off.

b. Sanitary Sewer Update.

- The generator at the lift station was damaged by mice, the repairs cost \$3,500 and were submitted to insurance.

c. Minnesota Pollution Control has approved our Schedule of Compliance timetable prepared by Bollig.

7. Fire Department

a. Need to consider adding a generator for City Hall/Fire Department. When the power went out on 1/21/26 for four hours the FD was unable to open the door to get out they emergency vehicles to go on a call. Also concerned about the potential freezing of the Fire Trucks. It was also mentioned to look into the cost of adding a generator for the community center at the same time since it is the Emergency Shelter for Waldorf. Tabled, waiting on two quotes.

*Motion made to approve the Fire Department Report was made by Jamie, 2nd by Missy. Approved. Vote was 3/0. Cody and Carrie abstained.
